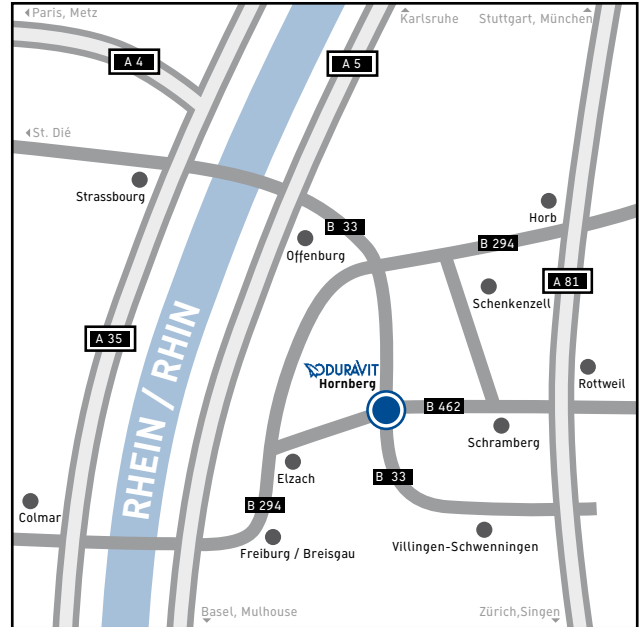


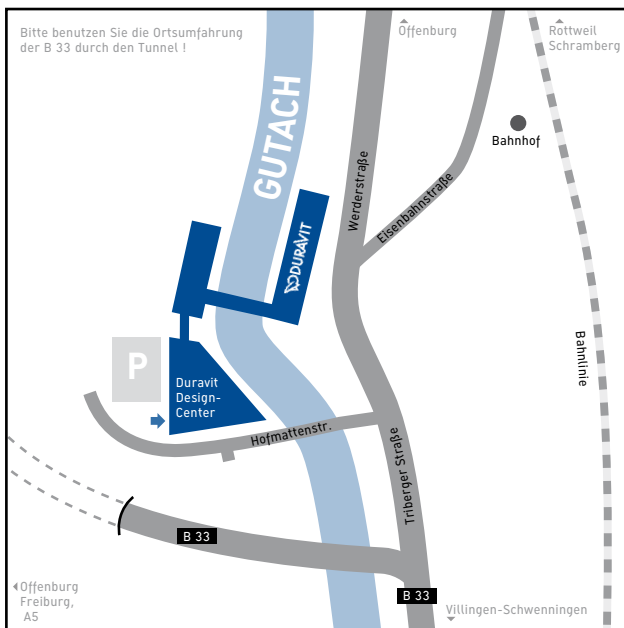
Directions to Hornberg



Our Hornberg head office is in the south of Germany, in the “border triangle” between France and Switzerland.



For Hornberg from Paris take the A4 via Strassbourg, or from Frankfurt take the A5 via Offenburg. Then continue on the B33. From Basel take the A5 to Freiburg, continue on the B294 to Elzach, then follow the signs to Hornberg. From Lake Constance take the A81 to Villingen-Schwenningen, then the B33. From Stuttgart take the A81 to Rottweil, the B462 to Schramberg, and then the L108 to Hornberg.



Duravit’s head office is at the edge of Hornberg. If you are travelling from Villingen-Schwenningen, you will see our company building several hundred metres past the town sign. Coming from the west along the B33, use the ring road through the tunnel that takes you straight to the entrance of the DDC. After the tunnel take two left turns into Hofmattenstraße. Coming from Schramberg, pass the station and continue to Werderstraße – Duravit is opposite the junction.
